Our pedagogy requires certain **skills**...

Be <u>clear communicators</u> with children, parents, colleagues and the wider community.

Be confident in pedagogical conversations, talking about teaching and learning.

These conversations need to stimulate interest and motivate engagement by being dynamic and differentiating.

And remember to check progress regularly!

Using appropriate language is essential to promote cultural capital and development.



Instead of, this is bad and that is nice —> this is terrible and that is exquisite!

Recognise the power of language to make learning engaging and inevitable.

Be the interested person next to the interested child - watch, listen and respond to children using model language.

Support children to recognise and respond to their own physical needs.

For this culture to be continuously right, we want people who want to get their finger prints all over it, because our culture is always changing.



Reading and being aware of our policies is an essential part of staff induction.


It gives you a good starting point for making decisions.
